

GETTING TO THE ORANGE WARSAW FESTIVAL SITE

What is the best way to get to the Orange Warsaw Festival?

The Orange Warsaw Festival takes place at the Służewiec Race Track.

You can get there by public transport, by car or by taxi.

Those **wearing a festival wristband** get free rides on public transport (buses, trams, underground and Rapid Urban Rail trains) on 30-31 May and 1 June until 4 am.

PKP Warszawa Centralna/Warsaw Central Station

Go to the Metro Centrum station and take the M1 line to the WILANOWSKA Metro station (direction KABATY), then from the WILANOWSKA Metro junction to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus no. 331, 709, 727, or 739 (get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or tram lines: 4, 10 (direction “WYŚCIGI”, end stop). You will have to manage a long ramp and an uneven pavement. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

PKP Warszawa Gdańska/Warsaw Gdańska Station

Walk to the Dworzec Gdański Metro station and take the M1 line to the WILANOWSKA METRO station (direction KABATY), then from the WILANOWSKA METRO junction to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus no. 331, 709, 727, 739 (you have to get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or tram number 4, 10 (direction WYŚCIGI, final stop). You will have to manage a long ramp and an uneven pavement. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

PKS/PKP Warszawa Zachodnia/Warsaw West (intercity and international buses and trains)

Direct bus line 136 from the stop “RONDO ZESŁAŃCÓW SYBERYJSKICH 03” gets to the on-demand stop “WYŚCIGI 03”.

Bus line 167 from the bus terminal (stop “DWORZEC ZACHODNI 01”) to the stop “METRO POLE MOKOTOWSKIE”. Then change to metro line M1 and travel to METRO WILANOWSKA STATION (direction KABATY). Later, from the METRO WILANOWSKA junction to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus lines: 331, 709, 727, 739 (get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or tram lines: 4, 10 (direction “WYŚCIGI”,

end stop). There are step lifts on the route leading from the platforms. There are also ramps on the way to the stop. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

Flixbus. Metro Młociny junction

Go to the MŁOCINY METRO station and take the M1 line to the WILANOWSKA METRO station (direction KABATY), then from the WILANOWSKA METRO junction to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus no. 331, 709, 727, 739 (get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or by trams: 4, 10 (direction “WYŚCIGI”, end stop). There are step lifts on the route leading from the platforms. There are also ramps on the way to the stop. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

Flixbus. Metro Al. Wilanowska junction

It is possible to get from the METRO WILANOWSKA junction to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus lines: 331, 709, 727, 739 (get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or by trams: 4, 10 (direction “WYŚCIGI”, end stop). It will be necessary to overcome a long ramp and uneven pavement. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

Chopin Airport

The direct bus line is 331, getting to the “WYŚCIGI 02” bus stop. Take bus line 148 from Chopin Airport to POLECZKI junction. Then walk along the western pavement along Puławska Street to the main gate or take bus lines 192, 331, 709, 739 to the “WYŚCIGI 01” bus stop. It will be necessary to cross the uneven pavement.

Modlin Airport

You can take a train from MODLIN GŁÓWNY train station to WARSZAWA ŚRÓDMIEŚCIE or WARSZAWA CENTRALNA (depending on the connection). Then walk to Metro Centrum station and go to METRO WILANOWSKA station (direction KABATY). Next, from the METRO WILANOWSKA junction, you can get to the Służewiec Race Track site by bus lines: 331, 709, 727, 739 (get off at the stop “WYŚCIGI 01”) or tram lines: 4, 10 (direction “WYŚCIGI”, end stop). It will be necessary to overcome a long ramp and uneven pavement. Low-floor trams are marked on the timetable.

Return from the festival by public transport

On the night from Friday to Saturday and on the night from Saturday to Sunday between 11:00 p.m. and approx. 3:00 a.m. a bus line "DO METRA" will run between the "WYŚCIGI" stop and the METRO URSYNÓW metro station. For the duration of the Orange Warsaw Festival, the M1 metro line will have extended running hours and the departure of the last bus will be coordinated with the last metro train from METRO URSYNÓW station.

Parking spaces for audiences with disabilities

Parking for people with disabilities is located very close to the festival entrance gates at the Służewiec Race Track site.

When entering the site, you must present your N Ticket, a valid Parking Card and a previously purchased N Parking Ticket.

Kiss & Ride

You can use the "Kiss and Ride" option - being dropped off at the Priority Service Point, which is near the festival entrance gates. To use this, you will need to show Ticket N. This is an option for taxi transport too.

Warsaw City Bicycle and private bikes

There are two bicycle stations near the area of the Służewiec Race Track:

1) station number 9604 METRO URSYNÓW; 2) station number 9609 PUŁAWSKA-PILECKIEGO. Just near the entrance to the festival area, there are places to return the city bikes (at the "WYŚCIGI" stops).

There will be a parking area for private bicycles near the entrance gates to the festival site from Puławska Street.
